#### THE INDEX OF LIFE SATISFACTION OF THE ELDERLY

In order to study the index of life satisfaction of the elderly, a survey of 120 respondents (average age 72 + 2 years 9 months) was conducted. Questionnaires were used to determine the socio-demographic indicators of respondents and psychological testing using the following methods: Life Satisfaction Index A, LSIA, adapted by N.V. Panina 1993; Spielberger's eight-factor personality questionnaire (STPI). Statistical processing of the results was carried out using the SPSS 22.0 program, the Kolmogorov-Smirnov criterion and the Mann-Whitney criterion were applied. The results of the study can be used to determine the targets of psychosocial assistance and in the development of psychological support trainings for older people living in frontline territories.

### FEATURES OF THE EMOTIONAL INTELLIGENCE OF ADOLESCENTS: THE IMPACT OF THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

The article reveals the features of emotional intelligence in adolescents before and during the COVID-19 pandemic. An empirical study was conducted on the basis of schools in the Republic of Mari El and the Kirov region to study emotional intelligence (sampling of the study before the pandemic (2020) – 793 teenagers, during the pandemic (2021) – 667 students). Data collection was carried out using the «Emotional Intelligence Questionnaire EmIn» by D.V. Lucina. As a result of the study, it was found that during the pandemic, adolescents had a significant decrease in the level of interpersonal emotional intelligence and understanding of emotions, but the indicators of intrapersonal and general emotional intelligence of adolescents increased. Sexual characteristics of the development of emotional intelligence were established: in a calm situation (before the pandemic), boys had significantly higher rates of individual scales of emotional intelligence; in a crisis situation (during a pandemic), girls showed the dynamics of values on these scales, and boys showed a significant decrease.
