The implementation of the described programs in practice will stabilize and improve the emotional state of clients, develop personal and professional competencies demanded by the labor market, which will allow unemployed citizens to come to professional self-determination and find a job.

Tsuvarov, as well as the questionnaire of unfinished proposals, developed by the staff of the Krasnodar Higher Military Aviation School, are presented.

The psychological readiness of female cadets to perform the first independent flight can be characterized as a mental and active state, which manifests itself in the mobilization of the psychophysiological and psychological resources of the individual to perform the flight. It is concluded that the psychological readiness of a cadet of a military flight school for the first independent flight should be considered as part of professional development and understood as a complex, integrated, integrative education, representing a dynamic structure and including a wide variety of different components that affect the quality of the flight task.
