## PECULIARITIES OF SELF-REGULATION OF STUDENTS WITH DIFFERENT LEVEL OF DISINTEGRATION IN THE VALUE-MOTIVATIONAL SPHERE

The article examines the problem of the development of conscious self-regulation in the psychological literature. Student age is considered as a sensitive period for the development of conscious self-regulation. The role of the value-motivational sphere in the development of conscious self-regulation is determined. Individual-typical self-regulation of students with different levels of disintegration in the value-motivational sphere was studied. The statistically significant differences in the features of planning, modeling, programming, evaluation of results, flexibility and independence of students with high, medium, low level of disintegration in the value-motivational sphere are revealed. Recommendations for the development of conscious self-regulation in student age are proposed.

### INTERRELATION OF TRUST TO THE EQUIPMENT WITH PROFESSIONAL WELLBEING OF SPECIALISTS

The results of the research of interrelation of indicators of trust to the equipment and professional wellbeing of operators of nuclear power plants and employees of locomotive crews are presented. The general result for both professional groups is to identify positive correlations

only between indicators of trust to the equipment and professional wellbeing. The differences in the structure and number of the correlations between considered indicators in compared professional groups are detected. The three-factor structure of indicators of trust to the equipment and professional wellbeing of operators of nuclear power plants is revealed. Along with that all indicators of trust to the equipment are correlated with all indicators of professional wellbeing. The six-factor structure of the indicators of trust to the equipment and professional wellbeing of employees of locomotive crews is revealed. At the same time the number of correlations between trust to the equipment and professional wellbeing is almost eight times less than number of indicators of operators of nuclear power plants.
