PSYCHOLOGICAL STRUCTURE OF PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS AND PROFESSIONAL-IMPORTANT QUALITIES OF FIRE-RESCUE FIRMERS

The object of the research in this work was the leading personal characteristics and professionally important qualities of firefighters-rescuers, on the basis of which the psychological structural model of an effective professional is being developed. The aim of the study was to identify and interpret the indicators of the blocks of personal qualities of the subjects: emotional, communicative, intellectual and self-regulatory. To solve this goal, the 16-factor personality questionnaire of R. Kettell was used. The results of the study demonstrate that firefighters rescuers have such pronounced qualities as willingness to take risks, decisiveness, courage, stress resistance and moderate social introversion.

PSYCHOLOGICAL VECTOR FOR OVERCOMING EMOTIONAL BURN OUT SYNDROME IN ONCOLOGISTS

Maintaining health in the professional activities of oncologists initiates the development of a system of psychological support for oncologists, including psychological trainings, group and individual counseling in the context of the problems of their professional activities. The article presents the results of approbation of the psychological training program and psychological data confirming its effectiveness in the prevention and correction of professional burnout of doctors. The article presents the results of psychological diagnostics before and after training using V.V. Boyko to study the level of emotional burnout of doctors.

SPECIFICITY OF THE RELATIONSHIP OF EMOTIONAL INTELLIGENCE AND STYLE FEATURES OF MANAGEMENT DECISIONS

The object of research in this work is decision-making processes in the sphere of management. The goal of the study was to identify and interpret the characteristics of revealed relationship between emotional intelligence and styles of decision-making processes. To solve this task, an integrated methodological approach was used that combines two stages of organization and involves its implementation both at the analytical and structural levels. The main result of the study lies in the fact that predominantly negative influence of emotional intelligence on the effectiveness of preferred styles of managerial decision-making processes was identified. Also it was found that along with structural determination, emotional intelligence has a significant impact on the style features of managerial decision making processes, as well at the analytical level of this determination. This determination is presented in its triune forms — local, aggregative and integrative ones.

FEATURES OF PSYCHOLOGICAL CONTRACT OF LABOR SUBJECTS OF NETWORK ORGANIZATIONS

The article describes the relevance of the study of the psychological contract of labor subjects at the present stage of market development, the organization of the labor process and management in the context of the digital transformation of society, the transition of many traditional companies to Internet platforms. Approaches to the study of network forms of doing business are considered, the features of network-type organizations in comparison with traditional companies are described. The article presents the results of a pilot, empirical, comparative study of the implicit agreement of labor subjects of network and traditional companies, and the results of early studies of companies of the traditional type (from 2010 to 2019) with modern data. The prospects for the study of the psychological contract in organizations of a network type are considered.

VALUE ORIENTATIONS OF FUTURE LAWYERS IN THE PROCESS OF PROFESSIONAL FORMATION OF AN INDIVIDUAL

The results of an empirical research of the value orientations of future lawyers in the process of obtaining higher education are analyzed. The dynamics of the professional formation of a person at different stages of training is considered. The Schwartz Value Questionnaire was used. The

application of the Kruskal–Wallis H-test revealed significant differences between the studied groups. The study revealed statistically significant differences on the «Universalism» scale, which indicates that the respondents' choice of the legal profession was not accidental. When interpreting the differences in the data obtained, it can be concluded that similar quantitative indicators for the first and fourth courses hide different content. The indicators identified at the trend level on the scales «Independence», «Stimulation», «Security» and «Power» indicate the presence of psychological prerequisites for internal tension between professional duty and the desire for values included in these scales, the cumulative effect of which can be very noticeable.

The prerequisites for the formation of an art education center and a training system for future masters of fine arts are studied.

This article presents the results of an expert assessment of the activities that contribute to the development of professional orientation to information security, as well as the characteristics of the qualities (properties) of a person that contribute to the development of an information security culture. The object of the study is a professional orientation to information security. The purpose of the presented article is to identify effective directions for the development of professional orientation to information security. To achieve this goal, the following research methods were used: survey, expert assessment, correlation analysis. The results of the expert assessment made it possible to identify the most effective measures that contribute to the development of professional orientation to information security. The correlation analysis of the obtained results allowed us to determine the obvious dependencies between the considered personality qualities and to identify 3 main blocks of personality qualities: «Understanding of information security», «Professionally important qualities» and «General Cultural competencies». These blocks allow you to select diagnostic tools to assess the effectiveness of the implementation of the educational work program for the development of professional orientation to information security.
