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### METACOGNITIVE SKILLS AS A RESOURCE FOR SUCCESS IN TEACHING ACTIVITIES

The study revealed the features of self-efficacy in professional activities, readiness for professional and pedagogical self-development and professional apathy among physical education teachers in groups with different levels of metacognitive skills development. Cluster analysis shows the resource potential of metacognitive skills. Correlation analysis within clusters to determine the relationship of metacognitive skills with the components of professional activity effectiveness allowed us to establish that in the first cluster, the ability to regulate one's own emotional state, plan a problem solution in advance and create models for its implementation are included in improving the effectiveness of physical education teachers. ### DELIBERATENESS AND DEPRESSION AS CONSEQUENCES OF PROFESSIONAL QUALITIES IN PSYCHOLOGY STUDENTS: NONLINEAR DATA ANALYSIS

The article considers examples of asymmetric (one-sided) strong (SV>0.7) the simplest nonlinear dependencies in the problem for 114 indicators of 9 psychodiagnostic techniques (diagnostic data from psychology students), which show that when considering two reciprocal dependencies Y(X) and X(Y), they often do not correspond to each other in terms of the strength of the connection. The article quantitatively analyzes and qualitatively interprets the dependencies for two pairs of variables: 1) «Foresight – carelessness» and «Vigilant type» (questionnaires: «5-factor personality» and DSM-IV); 2) «Depression – emotional comfort» and «Caged» (questionnaires: «5-factor personality» and «Emotional burnout»).

students (future doctors). 110 medical university students took part in the study. The purpose of the study: to study the relationship between the socio-psychological climate in the educational team and the motivation of older adolescents to study. The hypothesis of the study: the formation of motivation for the education of older adolescents is interrelated with the degree of favorability of the socio-psychological climate of their educational team. The sample consisted of 34 students in grades 10-11 of the HSE Lyceum, of which 25 were girls and 9 were boys. Research methods: questionnaire «Climate in the classroom» (A.N. Lutoshkin), methodology for studying the motivation of high school students on the topic of the study. Conclusions: the degree of favorability of the socio-psychological climate in educational groups does not fully determine the high level of motivation for learning, but significantly affects the elements of the structure of learning motivation.

# PHONEME-GRAPHEME TRANSPOSITION IN CHINESE STUDENTS TRAINING E.V. Krapivnik

The article presents the experience of creating teaching materials for the formation of auditory pronunciation skills among teaching Russian to Chinese. Summarizing the practical experience of teaching Russian as a foreign language to a Chinese audience, using the methods of observation, survey and introspection, the author identified a number of common features characterizing Russian and Chinese sounds, which formed the basis of the description of the sound-letter correspondences of the Russian language, translated into Chinese. The author identified didactic possibilities of using phoneme-grapheme transposition in short-term training. It seems that descriptions of Russian sound-letter correspondences, made taking into account the phonetic features of the students' native language and accompanied by a commentary in this language, allow for a compact presentation of phonetic material, increasing the level of students' awareness and independence in learning, optimizing and intensifying the process of forming students' basic phonetic skills.
